1 John 1:9 - We must c_____ our sins in order to be forgiven.

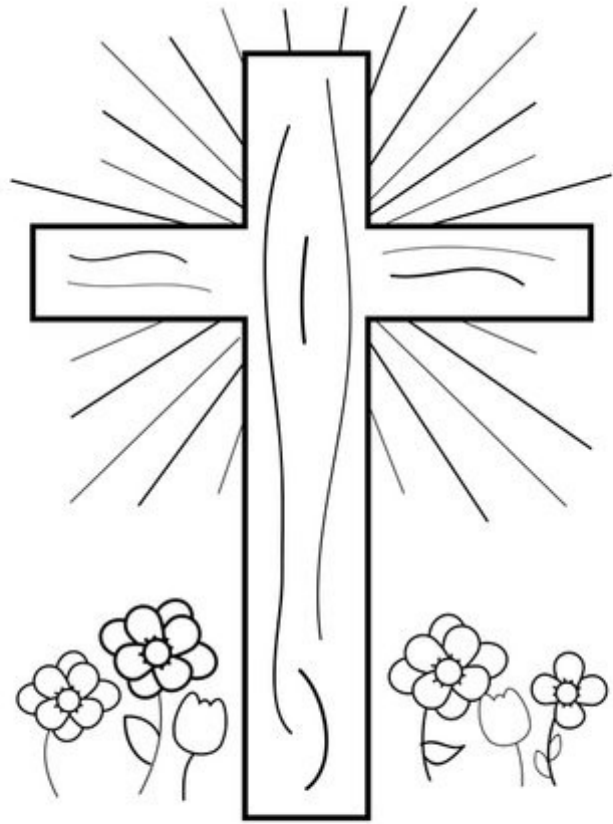
1 John 1:7 - Once our sins are forgiven, we must w_____ in the light of God’s holiness instead of the d_____ of our sin.

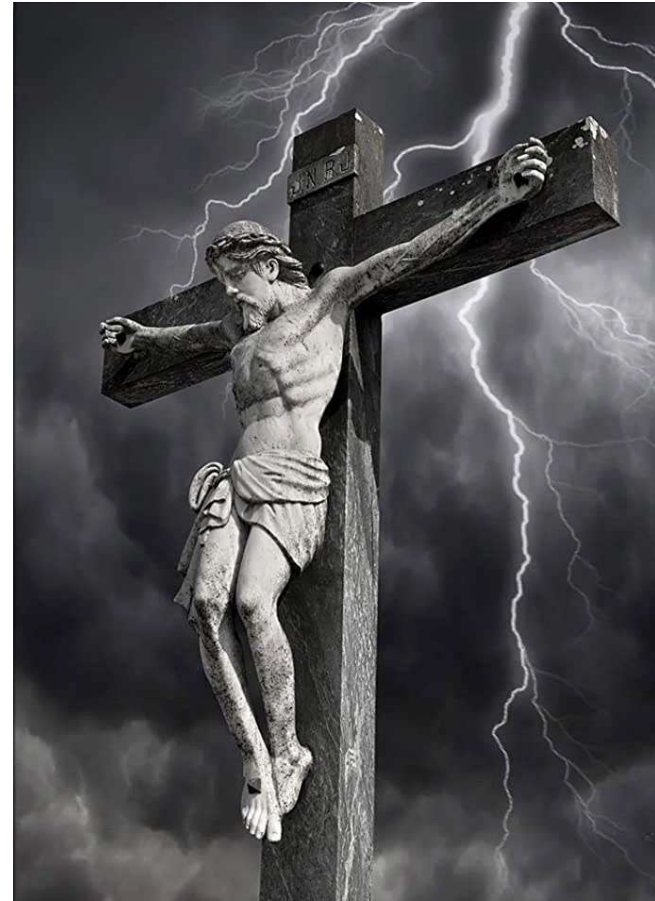
