

## Thanksgiving as a Way of Living #3 “The Act of Thanksgiving: Glorifying” selected Scriptures

Psalm 8:3-4 - David asked, “Why am I h\_\_\_\_\_?”

The Westminster Shorter Catechism begins with the question: “What is the chief end of man?” and answers: “Man’s chief end is to g\_\_\_\_\_ God and e\_\_\_\_\_ Him for ever.”

Psalm 69:30 - “I will praise God’s name in song and g\_\_\_\_\_ Him with t\_\_\_\_\_.”

“Glorify” means to “make g\_\_\_\_\_” or to “m\_\_\_\_\_.”

### The Appeal to Glorify the Lord

Psalm 34:3 - “Glorify the Lord with me; let us e\_\_\_\_\_ His name.”

Psalm 86:12 - “I will p\_\_\_\_\_ you, O Lord my God, with all my heart; I will g\_\_\_\_\_ your name forever.”

Psalm 147:7 - “S\_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord with thanksgiving; make m\_\_\_\_\_ to our God on the harp.”

### The Act of Glorifying the Lord

1 Chronicles 16:7-36 - We glorify God in our w\_\_\_\_\_ of Him.

Romans 15:5-9 - U\_\_\_\_\_ is a strong testimony to unbelievers.

1 Corinthians 10:31 - Whatever we do we do to the g\_\_\_\_\_ of God.
