Romans 12:1 - Mary shows what a l_____ sacrifice looks like.

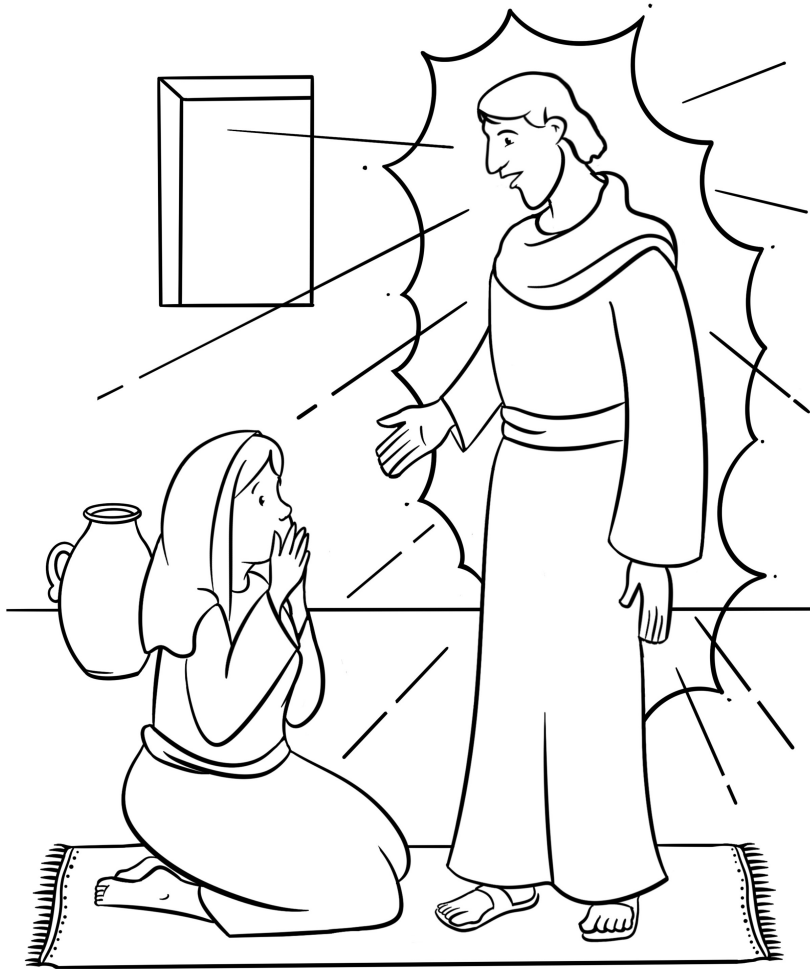
